Proclamation

Whereas, the President of the United States and the Governor of Oregon have designated April 12 - 18 as National Public Safety Telecommunicators Week; and

Whereas, professional telecommunicators are not visible as the men and women who arrive at the scene of emergencies, but provide a vital link to public safety services as part of the first responder team; and

Whereas, telecommunicators are critical to our county's emergency response and homeland security services, dispatching law enforcement, ambulances, firefighters, and other emergency responders 24 hours a day, seven days a week; and

Whereas, the members of the law enforcement agencies of Yamhill County, including City of Carlton Police Department, City of McMinnville Police Department, City of Yamhill Police Department, and Yamhill County Sheriff's Office, rely on the telecommunicators' compassion, understanding, and professionalism during the performance of their job to dispatch law enforcement services; and

Whereas, the members of the fire district agencies of Yamhill County, including Amity Fire District, New Carlton Fire District, Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde Emergency Services, Dayton Fire District, Lafayette Fire Department, McMinnville Fire District, Sheridan Fire District, West Valley Fire District, and Yamhill Fire Protection District, rely on the telecommunicators' compassion, understanding, and professionalism during the performance of their job to dispatch fire services; and

Whereas, the members of the ambulance service agencies of Yamhill County, including McMinnville Ambulance Service, Sheridan EMS Ambulance Service, and Confederated Tribes of the Grand Ronde Ambulance Service, rely on the telecommunicators' compassion, understanding, and professionalism during the performance of their job to dispatch ambulance services;
